Welcome to the WVFM Kids Market!

The WVFM is delighted to offer this opportunity for young entrepreneurs to sell their own handcrafts and home-grown produce. (Please note that resale and the sale of orchard fruits are not permitted.) In offering our children this unique opportunity we hope to introduce them in various skills: social interaction marketing, presentation and monetary skills.

To make this a safe and fun place for the children to be able to vend, there are a few simple rules:

- Children must be fifteen years of age or younger and accompanied by a responsible adult at all times while in the market. Vendor’s children may vend from their parent’s stall.
- All produce/products offered for sale must be grown or produced in Chelan, Grant or Douglas counties.
- Please ensure that your child is adequately hydrated and use sunscreen (if appropriate).
- To be able to vend in the market, arrival time is to be no later than 7:15 a.m .
- All food products sold in the market must be prepared in accordance with Chelan/Douglas Health District Rules.

Kids Market Agreement

I understand that my child must, grow, harvest, assemble or create the produce or product that he or she will sell at the market. I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Wenatchee Valley Farmers Market Association and the City of Wenatchee against any and all claims for alleged injuries to person or property on or off the premises arising out of use or occupancy of the premises by me. I shall defend at my own expense any action brought against the Association or the City based on my alleged acts or omissions.

Kids Market Additional Rules

Selling Time: No selling shall begin before 8 am or other designated opening time when the signal is given by the Market Manager indicating that the Market is officially opened.

Signage: Vendors shall post a sign at least 8.5" by 11" in size identifying themselves and/or their business name and location of their business. All produce and products must be clearly marked with their prices. This can be done by either individually tagging each item or with a sign listing all products and prices.

Canopy Setup: All vendors who wish to erect canopies on the Farmers Market site during the normal period of market operations, including the set up and break down period, are required to have their canopies sufficiently and safely weighted with approved weights. Weights must be at least 25 pounds each leg. Vendors who fail to properly anchor their canopies will not be allowed to sell on the day unless the vendor chooses to take down and stow the canopy and sell without it.

Stall Clean Up: Each vendor is responsible for keeping his/her stall space clean during the market and for complete clean up of the space at the end of the Market day. Market trash is NOT to be put into city trash bins located at or near the Market.

Live Animals in the Farmers Market: The WVFM recognizes that animals are effective and valuable teaching aids but due to the high risk posed of infection and/or injury we are unable to permit live animals to be brought into the Market. Please leave pets at home.
